

Wifi at the School



_TheCloud is available free of charge for unlimited wifi access, open to all guests, delegates and visitors at the School.

What is _TheCloud?

_TheCloud is the UK's largest public wifi network for fast and reliable internet connectivity. Many of the colleges and departments in the University of Oxford use _TheCloud for public and guest wifi access, immediately available when you arrive on campus

1. Connect to _TheCloud and open your browser, you will be redirected to _TheCloud logon page
2. On first using _TheCloud you'll be asked to setup an account, by providing an email address and setting a password. If you have used _TheCloud previously use your existing email and password
3. Thereafter your device will connect _TheCloud automatically



Alternatively if you are a member of the University with an Oxford SSO or a member of another academic institute you will be able to use Eduroam, again free of charge for unlimited wifi access

What is eduroam? Eduroam provides free wifi in all University of Oxford locations including the School. Eduroam is a global service providing free wifi globally to education institutes.

1. On your device connect to 'Eduroam' and enter in your Oxford SSO and corresponding password or if you are from another academic institute enter in your unique username from that institute and corresponding password.
2. Thereafter your device will connect _TheCloud automatically
